- 25 Registered Runners, 24 Starters, 22 Finishers.
 - 2 Relay Teams started and finished.
 - The Special Olympics of northwestern Montana came out a big winner, with Plum Creek Timber Company donating \$1100.00, which is \$50.00 for each runner who completed the long run. All finishers can take pride in both their personal accomplishment and the dividend of their efforts which will encourage athletic achievement for the physically and mentally impaired.
 - Rick Spady set a course record by 4 minutes and a personal record by 2 minutes as he returned to form for his 3rd win. Rick notched a marathon time of 2:53:30 en route.
 - Bobbie Dixon won the womens race for the 5th time in the 5 years of the event, recording her 2nd fastest time.
 - John Morelock set a new mens master record, bettering his 50-mile personal best by over an hour.
 - Rita Drain won the womens master race for her third time. This year she was not alone in her division, as Sylvia Quinn responded to the Le Grizz challenge and finished her 1st 50 miler. Sylvia is race director of the Lilac Bloomsday run, 2nd largest footrace in America, and the best-organized onslaught since D-Day.
 - Jerry Chambers showed the patience and savvy of a athlete twice his age in completing his 1st 50 miler. Jerry is 16.
 - The relay event was not well attended, but otherwise worked well and will probably be offered next year.
 - Weather was ideal, with clear skies and brisk autumn scenery. It warmed from 26 degrees at the 8 a.m. start to 60 degrees at the finish. 3 personal records were broken by 30 minutes or more in the perfect conditions.
